<u>Important Information regarding Gate Operation</u>

Unfortunately our gates were out of operation for a while whilst some changes were made and a part ordered. It was repaired last week without certain information being clearly understood resulting in a further problem.

There has been a, legally required safety change, which has altered the way the gates work slightly. As you approach the gates in your vehicle a sensor in the road some 8 metres away will detect your car and commence the opening procedure. There is a built in (legally required) 3 second delay. If in the meantime you move closer to the second set of sensors 3 metres away within that time the gates will believe there is an obstruction and remain closed. The solution is to hold back until the gates are clearly opening and then there should not be any problem. The implications of this were only realised once they were back in service and the need for a hashed marked 'keep clear' area, is being considered.

Managing Agents
