### **AGM**

All shareholders have previously been advised that the AGM to report on 2016 could not be held as scheduled because of an accounting problem with Encore. This has now been resolved and the accounts have been signed off. The Board does however expect the 2017 accounts to be delivered much earlier.

Dirty & stained paper & card Polystyrene e.g pizza bases, packaging inserts



Foil coated lids on yoghurt pots

Foil lined food pouches e.g. baby food, coffee pouches



Plastic film e.g. cling film, plastic film on meat & fish trays Plastic bags e.g. carrier bags, plastic food bags, bubble wrap
